A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT to amend "The Public Works Amendment Act, 1904." Title.

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. The Short Title of this Act is "The Public Works Amendment Act, 1905"; and it shall form part of and be read together with "The Public Works Act, 1894." Short Title.

2. (1.) Section five of "The Public Works Amendment Act, 1904," is hereby amended by repealing the words "forty feet," and substituting in lieu thereof the words "sixty links." Section 5 of Act of 1904 amended.

(2.) Nothing in the said section five shall be deemed to authorise the registration of any transfer or conveyance on the sale of any land as mentioned in section two of "The Public Works Act, 1903," unless and until the Registrar is satisfied that the requirements of subsection two of the last-mentioned section have been complied with.
