A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT to amend "The Railways Authorisation and Management Act, 1891." Title.

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. The Short Title of this Act is "The Railways Authorisation and Management Act 1891 Amendment Act, 1893." Short Title.

2. The provisions of "The Railways Authorisation and Management Act, 1891," shall be deemed to include power to make any part of the Wellington-Napier Railway, mentioned in the First Schedule to the said Act, upon or across that portion of the Harbour of Wellington which lies on the seaward side of the extension of the said railway, the middle line of which extension is defined in a Proclamation published in the *New Zealand Gazette* of the twenty-fifth day of February, one thousand eight hundred and ninety-two. "The Railways Authorisation and Management Act, 1891," to be deemed to include power to make part of the Wellington-Napier line on a certain part of Wellington Harbour.

And upon the issue of a Proclamation under "The Public Works Act, 1882," or any amendment thereof, taking the said portion of the harbour for such railway, the land comprised in such Proclamation may be reclaimed from the sea for the purposes of the said railway. Power to reclaim land taken under the Public Works Acts.

3. All moneys voted by Parliament for the reclamation of the said land, and the construction of railway works or buildings thereon, shall be applied and expended for such purposes under the control and direction of the Minister for Public Works. Moneys to be expended under direction of Minister for Public Works.
