A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT to amend "The Resident Magistrates Act, 1867."
Title.

WHEREAS it is expedient to amend "The Resident Magistrates Act, 1867:" Preamble.

BE IT THEREFORE ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same,
5 as follows:—

1. The Short Title of this Act is "The Resident Magistrates Act 1867 Amendment Act, 1879." Short Title.

2. Whenever any corporation or incorporated company shall be a plaintiff in any Resident Magistrate's Court, the application and deposition on oath required by section thirty-four of "The Resident Magistrates Act, 1867," shall (if in other respects sufficient) be deemed sufficient if made by any officer or agent of such corporation or incorporated company on behalf thereof. Application and affidavit may be made by officer or agent on behalf of corporation or incorporated company.
