HEREAS it is expedient to amend "The Resident Magistrates Preamble. Act, 1867:"

BE IT THEREFORE ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, 5 as follows:-

1. The Short Title of this Act is "The Resident Magistrates Short Title. Act 1867 Amendment Act, 1879."
