A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT to amend "The Rating on Unimproved Value Act, 1896." Title.

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in
5 Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. The Short Title of this Act is "The Rating on Unimproved Value Act Amendment Act, 1899." Short Title.

2. Notwithstanding anything to the contrary contained in "The
10 Rating on Unimproved Value Act, 1896," it is hereby declared that
in every case where under that Act provision is made for submitting
any proposal to the votes of the ratepayers in the district of a local
authority, such proposal shall be deemed to be carried if at the poll
taken on such proposal the number of valid votes recorded in favour
15 of the proposal exceeds the number of valid votes recorded against
the same, each ratepayer having one vote and no more.
