A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT to amend "The Slaughterhouses Act, 1877."

Title.

WHEREAS doubts have arisen as to the power of establishing abattoirs and slaughterhouses within the limits of boroughs, and it is expedient to remove such doubts :

Preamble.

BE IT THEREFORE ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows :—

1. The Short Title of this Act is "The Slaughterhouses Act 1877 Amendment Act, 1879;" and it shall be deemed to be incorporated with, and shall be read with, "The Slaughterhouses Act, 1877," (herein called "the said Act").

Short Title.

2. Notwithstanding anything to the contrary contained or implied by the said Act, from and after the coming into operation of this Act, no abattoir shall be erected or established within the limits of any borough, and no license shall be issued in respect of any slaughterhouse situated within the aforesaid limits.

No abattoirs or slaughterhouses to be within boroughs.
