A BILL INTITULED

An Act to amend "The Slaughterhouses Act, 1877."

Title.

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1. The Short Title of this Act is "The Slaughterhouses Act Short Title. 1877 Amendment Act, 1884; " and it shall be deemed to be incorporated with, and shall be read with, "The Slaughterhouses Act. 1877," herein called "the said Act."

2. Notwithstanding anything contained in sections thirty-eight Road Boards and 10 to forty, both inclusive, of the said Act, the Road Boards and Town Town Boards in certain cases to have Boards of the road districts and town districts existing within counties wherein, but so long only as, "The Counties Act, 1876," is not fees, &c. in operation, shall, within the limits of their respective jurisdictions, have all the powers granted by the said Act to County Councils

15 in respect to the inspection of slaughterhouses; and all fees and penalties accruing within such jurisdictions under the said Act shall belong to such road districts or town districts, as the case may be, and shall be paid by the Magistrates receiving the same to the Boards thereof respectively: Provided that the consent of such Road Board or Town Board shall not be given to the issue of a license for any slaughterhouse being within a distance of one mile from any abattoir, unless such slaughterhouse shall have been erected for the purpose immediately before the date of the passing of this Act.
