A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT to amend the Shops and Offices Act, 1921. Title.

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority  
5 of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the Shops and Offices Short Title.  
Amendment Act, 1934, and shall be read together with  
and deemed part of the Shops and Offices Act, 1921  
(hereinafter referred to as the principal Act).

10 2. Any apprentice or learner under a contract, whether Section 11 (*f*) of  
for hire or reward or not, whereby such person is to learn principal Act  
or be taught a trade, shall be deemed to be a shop-assistant amended.  
for the purposes of paragraph (*f*) of section eleven of the  
principal Act if such person is engaged in any way in  
15 connection with the business of a shop.
