An Act to amend "The Salmon and Trout Act, 1867." Title. BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. The Short Title of this Act is "The Salmon and Trout Act Short Title.

1867 Amendment Act, 1884."

2. Wherever in "The Salmon and Trout Act, 1867," the word Words "river" or "triver" or 'stream'' to include or words "river" or "stream" is or are used, the said words shall be "stream" deemed to include and apply to any lake or lakes.
