A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT to repeal certain Provisions of "The South Island Native Reserves Act, 1883." Title.

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

5 **1.** The Short Title of this Act is "The South Island Native Reserves Act 1883 Amendment Act, 1884." Short Title.

2. Sections four to fourteen inclusive of the said Act are hereby repealed. Repeal of sections 4 to 14 of principal Act.

10 **3.** Section three of the said Act is hereby repealed in so far as the same prohibits the dealing with the lands comprised in the First Schedule of the said Act by the Native grantees thereof; but it shall not be lawful for the Native grantees of the said lands to deal with
15 premium, or foregift, or any premium for the refunding to the tenant of any sums spent or claimed to have been spent by any tenant of such land in the improvement of the land comprised in his lease. Section 3 of the said Act amended.
