MOST GRACIOUS SOVEREIGN,—We, Your Majesty's most
 dutiful and loyal subjects, the House of Representatives of
 New Zealand in Parliament assembled, towards making good the
 Supply which we have cheerfully granted to Your Majesty in this
 session of Parliament, have resolved to grant unto Your Majesty the
 sums hereinafter mentioned, and do therefore most humbly beseech
 Your Majesty that it may be enacted, and be it enacted by the General
 Assembly of New Zealand in this present Parliament assembled, and
 by the authority of the same, as follows:—
