A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT to amend "The Trustee Act, 1883."

Title.

WHEREAS doubts have arisen as to the powers of a Registrar of the Supreme Court acting in pursuance of "The Supreme Court Practice and Procedure Acts Amendment Act, 1893," to exercise the jurisdiction and powers conferred on the Court, and which by "The Trustee Act, 1883," may be exercised and put in force by any Judge of the Court, and it is desirable to end such doubts :

Preamble.

BE IT THEREFORE ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows :—

1. The Short Title of this Act is "The Trustee Act Amendment Act, 1899."

Short Title.

2. Section sixty-six of "The Trustee Act, 1883," is hereby amended by inserting, next after the words "Judge of the Court," the words "or by any Registrar of the Court acting in pursuance of 'The Supreme Court Practice and Procedure Acts Amendment Act, 1893.'"

Section 66 of "The Trustee Act, 1883," amended.

3. All orders made or professed or intended to be made under "The Supreme Court Practice and Procedure Acts Amendment Act, 1883," or any of the Acts repealed thereby, in relation to any of the powers conferred on the Court or a Judge by "The Trustee Act, 1883," shall be deemed and held to be as valid and effectual to all intents and purposes as if this Act had been in force when the orders were made.
