TE AROHA BOROUGH RESERVE.

A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT to vest in the Corporation of the Borough of Te Aroha certain Land as a Municipal Reserve. Title.

5 WHEREAS the land described in the Schedule hereto, hitherto vested in Her Majesty the Queen, was originally surveyed and laid off in streets and sections as portion of a proposed Te Aroha Township, but is not now required for such, and is unoccupied: And whereas it is expedient that the same shall be utilised for the Borough of Te Aroha as a reserve for municipal purposes: Preamble.

10 BE IT THEREFORE ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. The Short Title of this Act is "The Te Aroha Borough Reserve Act, 1899." Short Title.

15 2. The piece of land described in the Schedule hereto shall, by virtue of this Act, be vested in the Mayor, Councillors, and Burgesses of the Borough of Te Aroha, to be held by them for an estate in fee-simple, but without power of sale, as a reserve for municipal purposes. Reserve vested in Te Aroha Borough.

SCHEDULE.

Schedule.

ALL that piece of land in the Auckland Land District, being Town Blocks II., V., VI., IX., X., XIII., XIV., XVII., XVIII., part of XXI., XXII., and XXIII., Te Aroha Town, situate in Block IX., Aroha Survey District, containing by admeasurement 62 acres, more or less. Bounded towards the north by a road reservation along the Waihou or Thames River; towards the east by a road; towards the south by a road and a gravel reserve; and towards the west by a railway reserve: inclusive of all streets within the boundaries set forth in the above description.
