A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT to amend the Town Boards Act, 1908. Title.

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority
5 of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the Town Boards Amendment Act, 1934, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Town Boards Act, 1908. Short Title.

2. Sections thirty-seven and thirty-eight of the
10 Municipal Corporations Act, 1933 (except the words
“ or before he has made and subscribed a declaration in
the form in the Second Schedule hereto ” in subsection
two of the said section thirty-eight, and the proviso to
that subsection), shall, with the necessary modifications
15 and in so far as the same are applicable, apply to
members of Town Boards. Sections 37 and
38 of Municipal
Corporations
Act, 1933, to
apply with
modifications.

3. Subsection one of section twenty-two of the Town
Boards Act, 1908, is hereby amended by omitting the
words “ or becomes interested either solely or jointly with
20 any other person in any contract with the Board, other-
wise than as a member of any incorporated or registered
company or of any body corporate ”. Section 22(1) of
Town Boards
Act, 1908,
amended.
