A BILL INTITULED

Title.

AN ACT to constitute the Tapanui County.

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the Tapanui County Act, 1908.

Short title.

2. The Tapanui County is hereby constituted, and shall comprise all that portion of the Tuapeka and Clutha Counties already constituted under the Counties Act, 1886, particularly described in the Schedule hereto, and the boundaries of the Counties of Tuapeka and Clutha are hereby altered accordingly.

Tapanui County constituted.

3. From and after the coming into operation of this Act, and during the existence of the county so constituted, no local authority other than the Tapanui County Council shall within the limits of the said county exercise any jurisdiction or authority over any roads, or over or in relation to any matter or thing in respect of which jurisdiction is conferred upon a County Council under the provisions of the Counties Act, 1886, or any amendments thereof or otherwise:

Jurisdiction of county.

Provided that nothing herein shall affect the power of the Governor to proclaim any portion of the said county a borough or town district.

SCHEDULE.

Schedule.

TAPANUI COUNTY.

ALL that area in the Otago Land District, commencing at the confluence of the Leithen Burn with the Pomahaka River; thence bounded towards the west generally by the Southland County to the northern boundary of Block VII, Wart Hill Survey District; thence towards the north by the northern boundaries of Blocks VII, VIII, IX, and X, Wart Hill Survey District; thence towards the west by the north-western boundary of Block VI, Bengier Survey District; thence by the northern boundary of said Block VI to Block IV, Bengier Survey District; thence bounded towards the east and north-east generally by part of said Block IV and by part of Allotment 30, Moa Flat Estate, to a road reserve; thence by the northern side of said road reserve and a public-road line, and across said road-line to the Town of

No. 12—1.

Httrick; thence by the said town and Allotments 3, 4A, across 4 to Allotment 5, Moa Flat Estate; thence by Allotments 5 and 6 to the western boundary of Block IV, Crookston Survey District; thence by said western and southern boundaries of said Block IV to the western boundary of Block I of said district; thence by said western boundary of said Block I; towards the south and south-east generally by a public road, and by a road and a road reserve, being the southern boundary of Block XVI, said Crookston Survey District; thence by the crossing of said road and by the eastern boundary of Sections 7 and 6, Block XIV, of said district; thence by the summit of the Blue Mountains to the Rankleburn; thence by the said burn to its confluence with the Pomahaka River; thence by the centre of the said river to a point in line with the northern boundary-line of Block VIII, Waipahi Survey District; towards the south by a line from the centre of said river to the northern boundary of said Block VIII, and by said Block VIII and Block IX of said district, and by Waikaka Survey District; towards the west by the eastern boundary-line of the Chatton Survey District, and by that line produced to the centre of the Leithen Burn; thence bounded again towards the north-east generally by the centre of said Leithen Burn to its confluence with Pomahaka River, being the commencing-point.
