A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT to amend the Town Districts Act, 1906.

Title.

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows :—

1. This Act may be cited as the Town Districts Act, 1907, and shall be read with and form part of the Town Districts Act, 1906 (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act).

Short Title.

2. Section two of the principal Act is hereby amended by omitting the words "under the principal Act."

3. (1.) Subsection three of section three of the principal Act is hereby repealed.

Repeal.

(2.) Section two hundred and fifty-one of the Counties Act, 1886 (which section is repealed by the principal Act), is hereby revived as from the time of the passing of the principal Act, and shall be deemed to have been in operation as from that time, subject, however, to the amendment hereinafter in this section provided.

(3.) Section two hundred and fifty-one of the Counties Act, 1886, is hereby amended as from the passing of the principal Act by inserting, after the words "town district" where these words first occur, the words "which is part of the county."

4. The second paragraph of section ten of the Town Districts Act, 1881 (which paragraph is repealed by the principal Act), is hereby revived as from the time of the passing of the principal Act, and shall be deemed to have been in operation as from that time, save in respect of those town districts which by virtue of subsection one of section three of the principal Act are not part of the county in which they are situated.
