A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT to increase the Borrowing Powers of the
Thames Harbour Board, and to amend the provisions of "The Thames Harbour Board Act, 1878," in respect thereof.

WHEREAS it is desirable to amend the provisions of "The Thames Harbour Board Act, 1878," in so far as it affects the powers of the Thames Harbour Board to borrow moneys thereunder:

BE IT THEREFORE ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. The Short Title of this Act is "The Thames Harbour Board Act 1878 Amendment Act, 1879."

2. Notwithstanding anything in section nine of "The Thames Harbour Board Act, 1878," or in any other section therein contained, it shall be lawful for the Thames Harbour Board to borrow and take up at interest, not exceeding *seven* per centum per annum, any sum (including any amounts which may have, under the authority of the said Act, been raised before the passing of this Act) not exceeding in the whole the sum of *fifty* thousand pounds, and no special Act shall be necessary for that purpose.

3. This Act and the said "Thames Harbour Board Act, 1878," shall be read and construed together as one Act: Provided however that any provisions of the said Act hereby amended which are repugnant to the provisions of this Act are and shall be taken to be by this Act repealed.
