A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT to increase the Powers of the Timaru Har- Title:
bour Board.

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

- 1. The Short Title of this Act is "The Timaru Harbour Board Short Title.
5 Empowering Act, 1879."
- 2. In addition to the powers conferred on the Timaru Harbour Landing service.
Board (hereinafter called "the Board"), by "The Harbours Act, 1878," there shall be conferred on such Board power to provide boats and apparatus in the opinion of the Board necessary for carrying on
10 the loading and unloading of vessels in the roadstead of Timaru.
- 3. The Board may out of the Harbour Board Fund pay for, Maintenance thereof.
provide, and maintain the boats and apparatus aforesaid.
- 4. "The Harbours Act, 1878," shall hereafter, so far as the same "Harbours Act,
1878," incorporated.
15 affects or shall affect the Board, be read as if the powers hereby conferred on the Board had been originally conferred by "The Harbours Act, 1878."
