A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT to remove in certain Cases the Parliamentary Disabilities Title.
affecting Officers of the Militia or Volunteers.

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in
5 Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as fol-
lows:—

1. The Short Title of this Act is "The Volunteer and Militia Short Title.
Officers' Parliamentary Privileges Act, 1899."

10 2. An officer of Militia or Volunteers shall not be deemed to be Removal of dis-
qualification of

Militia officers in
certain cases.
a Civil servant within the meaning of "The Disqualification Act,
1878," by reason merely of receiving any annual or permanent salary
in respect of such office, unless the amount of such salary exceeds *one*
hundred pounds in the year; and the provisions of that Act are
hereby modified accordingly.
