A BILL INTITULED

An Act to make Provision for a Site for the Victoria College Title. Buildings.

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in 5 Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as fol-

1. The Short Title of this Act is "The Victoria College Act Short Title.

Amendment Act, 1899."

2. As a site for the Victoria College buildings the Council of Lease of site for 10 that College is hereby empowered to take, and the Governors of the buildings. Wellington College and Girls' High School are hereby empowered and directed to grant, a lease of such portion (not exceeding ten acres) of the Wellington College site reserve as is agreed on between the parties; and with respect to such lease the following provisions 15 shall apply:-

(1.) The rental shall be nominal.

(2.) The term shall be nine hundred and ninety-nine years.

(3.) The lease shall be in such form, and shall contain such provisions (not inconsistent with this Act) as are agreed on between the parties.

3. If the parties are unable to agree in any matter under this Governor to decide Act, the Governor shall decide the same, and his decision shall matters in dispute.

be binding on the parties.

4. "The Wellington College and Girls' High School Act, 1887," "The Wellington College and Girls' 25 and every other Act in conflict with this Act are hereby modified in High School Act, 1887," and other so far as such conflict exists.

5. "The Victoria College Act, 1897," is hereby amended as Amendments of follows :—

(1.) As to section twenty-three, by substituting the word "Chairman" for the word "President."

(2.) As to subsection three of section thirty-six, by repealing the word "forty," and substituting in lieu thereof the word "fifty."

(3.) As to subsection five of said section thirty-six, by repealing the word "five," and substituting in lieu thereof the

word "six."

(4.) As to subsection six, (b), of said section thirty-six, by repealing the words "two years and three months," and substituting in lieu thereof the words "three years and three months."
