## A BILL INTITULED

An Acr to prevent the Treatment of Venereal Diseases by Unqualified Persons.

Title.

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand 5 in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:---

1. This Act may be cited as the Venereal Diseases Act, 1916.

Short Title.

2. Any person who supplies any medicine, lotions, washes, oint- Persons not ments, or any and every medicament purporting to be for the qualified treating treatment of any venereal disease and who is not a duly qualified performing an illegal act, and illegal act. medical practitioner is hereby declared to perform an illegal act, and shall be liable to a fine not exceeding twenty pounds for each offence Fines. so committed; and, if convicted more than once of committing this offence, he shall be liable to a fine of fifty pounds, and shall be 15 further liable to a term of imprisonment not exceeding two years.

3. Every public hospital shall provide an outdoor patients' Public hospitals to venereal diseases department, and shall supply free of cost to provide special department for patients all medical requirements for the treatment of these free treatment.
