A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT to amend the Workers' Compensation Act, Title.
1922.

5 BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the Workers' Compensation Amendment Act, 1934 (No. 2), and shall be read together with and be deemed part of the Workers' Compensation Act, 1922. Short Title.

10 2. Subsection six of section ten of the Workers' Compensation Act, 1922, is hereby amended by inserting, after the words "arsenic poisoning", the words "pneumoconiosis or miners' phthisis". Section 10 of Workers' Compensation Act, 1922, amended.

15 3. This Act shall not bind the Crown. Act not to bind the Crown.
