A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT to amend the Workers' Compensation Act 1922. Title.

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority
5 of the same, as follows:

1. This Act may be cited as the Workers' Compensation Amendment Act 1954, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Workers' Compensation Act 1922. Short Title.

10 2. Part I of the Workers' Compensation Amendment Act 1950 is hereby amended as from the commencement of that Part by inserting, after section thirty-four, the following section: Workers' Compensation Board may establish special funds and reserves.
