A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT to enlarge the Time wherein Reserves for Natives may be made under "The Waikato Confiscated Lands Act, 1880." Title.

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows :—

1. The Short Title of this Act is "The Waikato Confiscated Lands Act, 1884." Short Title.

2. The power of the Governor to make reserves of land under the second section of "The Waikato Confiscated Lands Act, 1880," Power of making reserves revived for two years.
is hereby revived, and any such reserve may be made under the afore-said section at any time before the expiration of two years from the passing of this Act.
