A BILL INTITULED

An Act to amend "The Westland Churches, Schools, and Hospital Title. Vesting Act, 1892."

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in 5 Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:--

1. The Short Title of this Act is "The Westland Churches, Short Title.

Schools, and Hospital Vesting Act Amendment Act, 1893."

2. Section (\bar{b}) of subsection three of section two of "The West- Act of 1892 partly 10 land Churches, Schools, and Hospital Vesting Act, 1892," herein referred to as "the said Act," and also so much of the First Schedule of the said Act as defines a part of the Education Reserve numbered one hundred and twenty-eight (in red) as being set apart for a Roman Catholic Church, Presbytery, and School Reserve, is hereby 15 repealed.

3. Subject as hereinafter mentioned, the School Commissioners Amended descripfor Westland are hereby authorised to convey in fee-simple the tion of reserve made for Roman Catholic land described in the Schedule to this Act to the Right Reverend purposes at John Joseph Grimes, Doctor of Divinity, Roman Catholic Bishop of Kumara.

Bounded towards the north-east by Tui Street; towards the south-east by Fourth Street; towards the south-west by Town Belt South; towards the north-west by Third Street: and which said piece or parcel of land is delineated on the map showing the town sectional subdivision of the Kumara portion of the said Reserve No. 128 (in red).
