A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT to constitute the Waimate North County.

Title.

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

The boundaries of the Hawera County are as hereby altered <del>accordingly, and are described in the Second Schedule hereto.</del> | Waimate North County constituted.         |
| 15 | (2.) The said Waimate Road District is hereby abolished, and shall be deemed to be merged in the Waimate North County hereby constituted, and the provisions of section fifty-seven of the <i>Counties Act, 1886</i> , shall apply accordingly.  |   |

## SCHEDULES.

## FIRST SCHEDULE.

## BOUNDARIES OF THE WAIMATE NORTH COUNTY.

ALL that area in the Land District of Taranaki bounded by a line commencing at the south-west corner of Section 1, Block V, Waimate Survey District; thence proceeding north along the western boundaries of Blocks V and I, Waimate Survey District, to the south boundary of Section 20, Block I, Waimate Survey District; thence due west to the middle of the Oeo Road opposite to the south-west corner of Section 20, Block I, Waimate Survey District; thence by a line along the middle of the Oeo Road to the southern boundary of Block IX, Kaipokonui Survey District; thence due east along the southern boundaries of Blocks IX, X, and XI, Kaipokonui Survey District, to the middle of the Palmer Road; thence south by a line along the middle of the Palmer Road to the northern boundary-line of Section 147, Block IV, Waimate Survey District; thence by a line due west to the north-east corner of Section 75, Block III, Waimate Survey District; thence in a line in a southerly direction along the eastern boundary-line of Block III, Waimate Survey District, to the Inaha Road; thence west to the middle of the Inaha Road; thence by a line along the middle of the Inaha Road to the sea; and thence ~~towards the west westerly~~ by the sea to the place of commencement, the sea being the southern boundary.

## SECOND SCHEDULE.

## BOUNDARIES OF THE HAWERA COUNTY.

ALL that area in the Taranaki Land District bounded towards the north by Eltham County from the junction of Palmer Road and Skeet Road to the junction of Koane Road and Rawhitiroa Road; thence towards the south-east generally by Patea County to the sea at the mouth of the Manawapou River; thence towards the south generally by the sea to the southern end of the Inaha Road; and thence towards the west by the Waimate North County as described in the First Schedule hereto to the place of commencement: excluding the Borough of Hawera.
