ADMINISTRATION ACT 1879 AMENDMENT BILL.

Mr. SAMUEL, in Committee, to move the following new clause:—

No person who shall have been appointed or shall be appointed an administrator upon an application made by him as the attorney or agent for an executor or administrator absent from the Colony of New Zealand shall be deemed liable to account to any one in respect of his executorship or administratorship excepting only to the executor or administrator whose agent or attorney he was, or to any person who shall thereafter be appointed executor or administrator of the same estate.

COUNTIES ACT 1886 AMENDMENT BILL.

Mr. ANDERSON, in Committee, to move the following new clause:—

There shall not be imposed or collected upon any road or at any bridge under the control of a County Council a toll exceeding *one shilling* in respect of each animal, and *two shillings* in respect of each vehicle: Provided that nothing herein contained shall be deemed to affect any contract heretofore entered into by or on behalf of any County Council for the purpose of the construction of any bridge.
