AUCTIONEERS AMENDMENT BILL.

Mr. TANNER, in Committee, to move the following amendment :—

To insert the following new paragraph as an addition to section two of the principal Act :—

- (a.) “ Bidder ” means any person who makes any bid or offer to purchase, either verbally or in writing, at the time of the sale by auction of any goods or property, and the auctioneer shall in no case ignore or refuse to take the bid of any bidder on the ground that such bidder does not belong to any trade, calling, occupation, or profession the members of which are or may be deemed to be most interested in the sale, or on any other ground whatever, provided the bidder shows his ability to complete the purchase ; such refusal shall be an offence against this Act.
