AUCTIONEERS AMENDMENT BILL.

Mr. WITTY, in Committee, to move the following amendments:—

To add the following new clause:

Lots to be sold
to highest
bidder at
certain sales.

5A. At any auction sale of fish, fruit, or vegetables, every lot shall be sold to the highest bidder, and it shall not be lawful for any auctioneer to refuse to accept a bid from any person present at the sale who is willing, or who states that he is willing, to pay cash for the goods on delivery thereof; and any condition or stipulation in conditions of sale in any manner violating this provision shall be void and of no effect.

To add to the Schedule:

Section 10 | Omit all the words after the words "local authority."
