

EXPLANATORY NOTE

THE proposed new *clause 4* differs from that in the Bill by reducing from five to four the number of representatives of employers and of workers on New Zealand Committees, and providing that, if the organisations of employers and workers concerned agree, the number of representatives of employers and of workers shall be reduced to three.

The clause also provides that an organisation of employers and an organisation of workers may each nominate a deputy to act in the absence of any of its representatives on a New Zealand Committee, and makes other consequential changes relating to quorum and other incidental matters.
