

# SUPPLEMENTARY ORDER PAPER.

### AGED AND INFIRM PERSONS PROTECTION BILL.

Hon. Mr. HERDMAN, in Committee, to move the following amendments:—

Clause 4: To insert the word "First" before the word "Schedule," in line 23.

To insert the following new clause:—

Court may  
make protection-  
order under this  
Act in respect  
of estate of  
person addicted  
to excessive use  
of alcoholic  
liquors, &c.

4A. Where it is made to appear to the satisfaction of the Court that any person is, by reason of his taking or using in excess alcoholic liquors, or any intoxicating, stimulating, narcotic, or sedative drug, unable wholly or partially to manage his affairs, whether such inability is continuous or occasional, the Court may make a protection-order in or to the effect of the form in the *Second* Schedule hereto, anything in the Reformatory Institutions Act, 1909, or in any other Act to the contrary notwithstanding.

To omit the Schedule, and substitute the following:—
