HOSPITALS AND CHARITABLE INSTITUTIONS BILL.

Mr. Whyte, in Committee, to move that the following subsection be added to clause 74:—

Also in cases where the settlers are unable to avail themselves of any existing hospital, and when the local bodies desire to establish one, a new district having been declared, a sum equal to two pounds for every pound of grants by contributing local bodies, subscriptions, receipts, or donations received, may be paid during the first five years following the establishment of such hospital.

AUCTIONEERS BILL.

Hon. Mr. Dick, in Committee, to move the following amendments:—

Clause 8. To add the following words:—"Provided that where certain members only of a partnership intend to conduct sales by auction, it shall be sufficient if such members only become licensed as auctioneers."

Clause 12. To omit the words "exercise his business as an auctioneer," and to substitute in lieu thereof "conduct any sale by auction."

Clause 13. After the word "sale-room," to omit the word "and," and to substitute in lieu thereof "within one half-hour previous to the time of any intended sale by auction, or."

Clause 19. To omit all the words after "public pounds," and to insert the following in lieu thereof:—"Nor to any sales made at a bazaar, or on any occasion where property of any kind is disposed of exclusively for a religious or charitable object."

MUNICIPAL CORPORATIONS ACTS AMENDMENT BILL.

Mr. Barron, in Committee, to move the following new clauses:-

Sections ninety-two to ninety-six inclusive of the said Act are hereby repealed.

The Governor may, from time to time, appoint any one or more person or persons, as he shall think fit, to be an Auditor or Auditors for any Council, and from time to time remove any such person or persons, and on the death, resignation, or removal of any such Auditor or Auditors may appoint any other person in place of any person or persons so dying, resigning, or being removed.
