AUCTIONEERS BILL.

Mr. MACDONALD, in Committee, to move, That clause 15 be struck out, and the following new clauses added:—

15. No person shall sell by auction any property except between the hours of six o'clock in the morning and eight o'clock in the evening of the same day, saving sales by auction of land, books, or works of art, of which sales he shall first give notice in writing to the clerk who has issued his license, and the clerk shall, on payment of a fee of *five* shillings in each case, register such intended sale, and issue a special permit for the same.

15A. No person holding a pawnbroker's license under any Act in reference to pawnbrokers shall be competent to hold an auctioneer's license.
