APPROPRIATION BILL.

Mr. SAUNDERS, in Committee, to move the following proviso to clause :—

Provided that, notwithstanding anything to the contrary contained in "The Public Revenues Act, 1891," and until an Imprest Supply Act shall be passed in the next session of the General Assembly, the authority of the Colonial Treasurer to issue and pay moneys in respect of any service shall not exceed the amount of the unexpended balance of the vote for such service provided by this Act, together with an amount equal to one-fifth part of the total of all salaries, pay, wages, allowances, mail contracts, rent, and other recurrent charges, and of all ordinary contingencies of any office or department provided for by such vote and set forth in the estimates relating thereto. And no payment shall be made for any services other than those for which provision is made in this Act and in the Estimates for the year ending the thirty-first day of March, one thousand eight hundred and ninety-five, or in excess of the scale herein set forth.
