APIARIES BILL.

Hon. Mr. McNAB, in Committee, to move the following amendment:—

Paragraph (b) of section 8 to be amended by striking out the words “colonies of,” and by substituting the words “honey from” for the words “queens reared in.” This part of the section would then read as follows:—

“No beekeeper shall—

“(b.) Sell, barter, or give away any bees or honey from an infected apiary, or any appliances used in such apiary.”
