ARMS BILL.

AMENDMENTS proposed by His Excellency the Administrator:—

Clause 3, subclause (5): To omit the subclause, and substitute the following subclause:—

(5.) The Minister of Finance shall pay compensation out of the Consolidated Fund for the value of all weapons in a serviceable condition, and for all ammunition or parts, delivered to an officer of police under the foregoing provisions of this section.

Clause 8, subclause (8): To omit the word “full” before the word “compensation” in the second line.

Clause 17, subclause (3): To omit the words “full compensation for the value thereof shall be payable therefor out of the Consolidated Fund,” and substitute the words “the Minister of Finance shall pay compensation therefor out of the Consolidated Fund.”

To insert after clause 24, the following new clause:—

Appeal to
Magistrate in
respect of
compensation
under this Act.

24A. The amount of compensation payable under any of the provisions of this Act, in respect of any arms, ammunition, explosives, or other property, shall not in any case exceed the actual market value thereof, and in case of dispute shall be determined by a Stipendiary Magistrate, whose decision shall be final.
