ARCHITECTS BILL

*Proposed Amendment*

Hon. Sir LÉON GÖTZ, in Committee, to move the following amendment:

*Clause (17) (1) (c):* To omit from lines 31 and 32 on page 11 the words "a period of three years ended at any time before", and substitute the words "the period of three years immediately preceding".

EXPLANATORY NOTE

Clause 17 (1) (c) (ia) of the Bill sets out a qualification for registration under the proposed Act which is to be available for 12 months after the Act comes into force. The qualification is that the applicant must satisfy the registering authority that he has for a period of three years ended at any time before the commencement of the Act been substantially and bona fide engaged as a principal in the practice of architecture in New Zealand.

The amendment now proposed will have the effect of requiring the period of three years to immediately precede the commencement of the Act.
