### AGRICULTURAL COMPOUNDS AND VETERINARY MEDICINES

#### *Proposed Amendments*

Dr. the Hon LOCKWOOD SMITH, in Committee, to move the following amendments:

*Clause 2 (1):* To amend *clause 2 (1)*—

- (a) By omitting the definition of the term “net national benefit”;
- (b) By omitting from paragraph (a) of the definition of the term “pest” the word “adversely”.

*Clause 11A:* To insert in subclause (2) (a), after the words “any information”, the words “received in respect of an application, other than information to which Part 6 applies”.

*Clause 22 (6):* To omit the word “proprietor”, and substitute the word “registrant”.

*Clause 26 (5):* To omit the words “agricultural compound”, and substitute the words “trade name product”.

*Clause 34 (2):* To omit the words “lay before”, and substitute the words “present to”.

*Clause 36 (1):* To omit the words “laid before”, and substitute the words “presented to”.

*Clause 57 (6):* To omit the words “at any time” the first time they appear.

#### EXPLANATORY NOTE

This Supplementary Order Paper makes consequential drafting changes.

The amendment to *clause 2 (1) in paragraph (a)* removes the definition of a term that no longer appears in the Bill.

The amendments to *clauses 2 (1) in paragraph (b), 22 (6), and 26 (5)* make 2 consequential changes to terminology resulting from decisions by the select committee.

The amendment to *clause 11A* clarifies the relationship between this clause and Part 6.

The amendments to *clauses 34 and 36* are changes in terminology resulting from changes made to Standing Orders after this Bill was introduced.

The amendment to *clause 57 (6)* corrects a drafting error.
