AUCKLAND CITY BORROWING.

Mr. HOLLAND, in Committee, to move the following amendment:—

Clause 5, subsection 6, line 50: To strike out all the words after the word "ratepayers" to the end of the subsection, and substitute the following in lieu of the words struck out:—

For the purposes of such a poll the provisions of section one hundred and eighty-two of "The Municipal Corporations Act, 1886," shall not apply, but in lieu thereof it is hereby enacted—

If a majority of the votes given upon the taking of any poll under the authority of this Act shall be in favour of the proposal upon which the poll shall be taken, then and in such case the said proposal shall be deemed carried, and the Council may proceed with such proposal accordingly; but, if not, then the said proposal shall be deemed rejected.
