Proposed Amendments

AW LIBRARY TATTO PHILLIP FIELD, in Committee, to move the following amendments:

> Clause 9: To insert, after subclause (4) (after line 13 on page 10), the following subclause:

(4a) At least one member of the South Pacific Arts Council shall be a member of the Council.

NOTE: This will ensure that the South Pacific Arts Council has direct representation and a voice on the main policy-making body of the structure, namely the Arts Council.

Clause 14: To omit subparagraph (i) of subclause (1) (d) (lines 7 and 8 on page 13), and substitute the following subparagraph:

> (i) Those of the Pacific Island people of New Zealand through the South Pacific Arts Council; the name of which Council shall be determined by that Council: and

NOTE: This amendment is to ensure that the South Pacific Arts body has the status of a Council, but for the removal of doubt, specifies that that body can determine its own name.

New clause 14B: To insert after the proposed new clause 14A (set out in Supplementary Order Paper No. 26) the following new clause:

14B. Functions of South Pacific Arts Council—In addition to any function specified in section 14 of this Act, the functions of the South Pacific Arts Council shall include the following:

(a) To allocate funding for Pacific Island arts:

(b) To keep the Arts Council of New Zealand fully informed, through the Arts Board, of all activities and developments relating to Pacific Island arts:

(c) To provide advice and make recommendations to the Arts Board as to the ways by which the functions of the Arts Council of New Zealand can be best carried out in respect of Pacific Island art:

(f) To carry out other functions as directed by the Arts
