ANZAC DAY BILL.

Right Hon. Mr. MASSEY, in Committee, to move the following amendments:—

Clause 2, subclause (1): To omit the words “and in all respects as if Anzac Day were a Sunday.”

To add the following subclauses:—

Licensed
premises to
be closed on
Anzac Day.

(3.) The provisions of section one hundred and eighty-nine of the Licensing Act, 1908, shall hereafter be construed to require the closing of licensed premises on Anzac Day in the same manner as they require the closing of such premises on Christmas Day and Good Friday.

Horse-racing
prohibited on
Anzac Day.

(4.) After the passing of this Act the Minister of Internal Affairs shall not grant a license under the Gaming Act, 1908, to any racing club to use the totalizator at any horse-race meeting proposed to be held on Anzac Day, and shall not grant a license under the Race Meetings Act, 1909, to any racing club to conduct horse-races on Anzac Day.
