AIR FACILITATION BILL

Proposed Amendments

Hon. W. ROB STOREY, in Committee, to move the following amendments:

Clause 3: To insert, after line 15 on page 1, the following definitions:

“Arrival hall” means an area determined pursuant to section 33 (2A) of this Act to be an arrival hall:

“Departure hall” means an area determined pursuant to section 33 (2A) of this Act to be a departure hall:

Clause 8: To insert in line 3 on page 4, after the word “identity”, the words “and that person’s boarding pass or ticketing or both”.

To omit subclause (3) (all the words in lines 6 to 8 on page 4), and substitute the following subclause:

(3) Every person commits an offence against this Act who fails to produce on demand that person’s passport or certificate of identity in accordance with subsection (2) of this section.

To insert in line 9 on page 4, after the word “identity”, the words “or boarding pass or ticketing”.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

Clause 3: The proposed amendments define, for the purposes of the Customs Act 1966, the terms “arrival hall” and “departure hall”.

Clause 8: The proposed amendments allow an immigration officer to inspect the boarding pass and ticketing of an “internationally ticketed passenger” who is travelling by air between 2 Customs airports in New Zealand.
