ARMED FORCES DISCIPLINE AMENDMENT BILL

Proposed Motion to Divide the Bill into 2 Bills

Hon. F. D. O'FLYNN, in Committee, to move as follows:

That *clauses 2 to 40* be a separate Bill, and that for clause 2 there be substituted the following Title, enacting words, and Short Title:

An Act to amend the Armed Forces Discipline Act 1971

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1. Short Title and commencement—(1) This Act may be cited as the Armed Forces Discipline Amendment Act 1985, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Armed Forces Discipline Act 1971 (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act).

(2) This Act shall come into force on the 1st day of January 1986.

That *clauses 41 to 43* be a separate Bill, and that for clause 41 there be substituted the following Title, enacting words, and Short Title:

An Act to amend the Courts Martial Appeals Act 1953

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1. Short Title and commencement—(1) This Act may be cited as the Courts Martial Appeals Amendment Act 1985, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Courts Martial Appeals Act 1953 (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act).

(2) This Act shall come into force on the 1st day of January 1986.
