AGRICULTURAL IMPLEMENT MANUFACTURE, IMPORTATION, AND SALE BILL.

Amendments proposed by His Excellency the Governor:—

Insert the following new clauses:—

- Power to grant bonus.** 7A. (1.) In any case where the Board recommends that relief be granted, it shall be lawful for the Commissioner to grant to the manufacturers of implements in New Zealand such bonus, not exceeding thirty-three per centum, as he deems necessary to enable manufacturers to compete with importers of such implements.
- (2.) The right to such bonus shall be subject to such terms and conditions as the Governor in Council thinks fit to impose.
- Power to refund duty on certain materials.** 9A. (1.) Whenever it is proved to the satisfaction of the Collector that duty-paid materials have been used in the construction of any implement he shall refund to the manufacturer of such implement the amount of duty paid on the materials so used.
- (2.) For the purposes of this section materials includes part of implements that cannot advantageously be manufactured in New Zealand.
