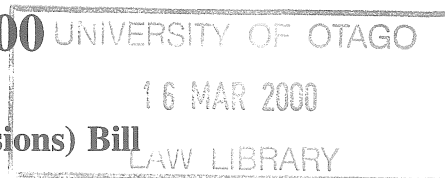

Accident Insurance (Transitional Provisions) Bill



Proposed amendments

Hon Dr Michael Cullen, in Committee, to move the following amendments:

Clause 6

To omit from line 28 on page 4 the words “providing services that are”.

New clause 10C

To omit from line 29 on page 8 the words “lay the documents before”, and substitute the words “present the documents to”.

New clause 10I

To omit from line 3 on page 13 the words “this Part”, and substitute the expression “**sections 10A to 10J**”.

Schedule 1

To insert, after line 4 on page 29, the following item:

Insert in paragraph (b) of the definition of the term **weekly compensation**, after the expression “section 286”, the expression “or **302B**”.

Explanatory note

This Supplementary Order Paper—

- amends *clause 6(1A)* to clarify that an insurer who transfers obligations under an accident insurance contract must give notice of the transfer to all third parties affected by the transfer:
- replaces a requirement in *clause 10C(3)* that documents referred to in that clause be laid before the House of Representatives with a requirement that the documents be presented to the House:
- effects minor and consequential amendments.
