Accident Insurance (Transitional Provisions) Bill



Proposed motion to divide Bill into 2 Bills

Hon Dr Michael Cullen, in Committee, to move as follows:

That *clauses 1 to 10J* be a separate Bill, and that for the enacting words, Title clause, and *clause 2* there be substituted the following enacting words, Title clause, and clause:

The Parliament of New Zealand enacts as follows:

1 Title

- (1) This Act is the Accident Insurance (Transitional Provisions) Act **2000**.
- (2) In this Act, the Accident Insurance Act 1998 is called "the principal Act".

2 Commencement

- (1) **Section 10J** comes into force on a date to be appointed by the Governor-General by Order in Council; and 1 or more Orders in Council may be made bringing different provisions of that section into force on different dates.
- (2) The rest of this Act comes into force on 1 April 2000.

That *Part 2 and the Schedules* be a separate Bill, and that for the heading above *clause 11* there be substituted the following enacting words, Title clause, and clause:

The Parliament of New Zealand enacts as follows:

1 Title

- (1) This Act is the Accident Insurance Amendment Act **2000**.

- (2) In this Act, the Accident Insurance Act 1998 is called “the principal Act”.

2 Commencement

- (1) **Section 14(c), Part 2 of Schedule 1, and Part 2 of Schedule 2** come into force on 1 July 2000.
- (2) The rest of this Act comes into force on 1 April 2000.
