ALIEN IMMIGRATION RESTRICTION BILL.

Rt. Hon. R. J. SEDDON, in Committee on this Bill, to move the following amendments:—

In clause 24 : Add to end of the clause, “and shall be deemed to have never been in operation.”

Insert the following new clause:—

19A. Notwithstanding anything hereinbefore contained, it is hereby declared as follows:—

(1.) In any case where any of the Australasian colonies recognises a certificate of naturalisation issued to any alien in New Zealand as entitling the holder to a corresponding certificate in such colony, a certificate of naturalisation issued to any alien in such colony shall entitle him to a corresponding certificate in New Zealand:

Provided that nothing herein contained shall apply to Chinese or Asiatics.

(2.) The Governor may from time to time make such regulation as he thinks fit in order to give effect to this section.
