COUNTIES ACT 1886 AMENDMENT BILL.

Mr. Flatman, in Committee, to move the following new clauses (as corrected):—

3. The principal Act is hereby amended as follows:—

Section one hundred and fourteen: By the addition of the words, "or the object or purport of such business," after the word "meeting," at the end of the section.

Section one hundred and twenty-four: By the omission of the words "by passing of a resolution," in the second line, and the insertion of the words "as follows" in lieu thereof.

Section one hundred and twenty-four, subsection one: By the omission of the word "adopted," and the insertion of the word "passed" in lieu thereof.

Section three hundred and four: By the omission of subsection two.

Section three hundred and eleven, subsection eleven: By the insertion of the following words after the word "employed," in the second line: "or other means of traction."

4. The production of the Gazette purporting to contain notification of the approval of the Minister for Public Works of any by-law, and also to contain a copy of the by-law, shall be conclusive evidence that all notices have been duly given, and publications made, and meetings duly convened and held, and resolutions duly passed and confirmed, and all other necessary steps taken and formalities performed that may have been required for the making of any by-law.

ALCOHOLIC LIQUORS SALE CONTROL ACT AMENDMENT BILL.

Dr. Newman to move, in Committee, the following new clauses:

. It shall not be lawful, from and after the period of from the passing of this Act, for any brewer to own or acquire, or have any estate or interest of whatsoever nature, whether at law or in equity, in any premises in respect whereof a publican's license shall for the time being be in force; nor shall it be lawful, after the same period of \_\_\_\_\_\_\_, for any brewer to own or acquire any estate or interest, whether at law or in equity, in any personal property in or upon any premises in respect whereof a publican's license shall for the time being be in force.

. After a period of from the passing of this Act, no publican's license shall be issued, transferred, or renewed, or otherwise dealt with under the provisions of "The Alcoholic Liquors Sale Control Act, 1893," or any amendments thereof, or otherwise in respect of any premises in which, or in any personal property in or upon which, any brewer has any estate or interest whatsoever.
