ALCOHOLIC LIQUORS SALE CONTROL ACT AMENDMENT BILL.

Mr. LANG, in Committee, to move the following amendment:—

Section 56 of "The Licensing Act, 1881," is hereby amended by inserting the words "of issue" after the word "days" in line 8 of the said section.

CUSTOMS DUTIES BILL.

Mr. MEREDITH, in Committee, to move,—

That wheat, oats, barley, and potatoes be admitted free of duty.

Mr. CARNELL, in Committee, to move,—

That cement required for harbour-works be admitted duty free.

Mr. SAUNDERS, in Committee, to move,—

That the duty on woollen fabrics and on boots and shoes be reduced from 25 to 10 per cent. *ad valorem*
