ALCOHOLIC LIQUORS SALE CONTROL ACT AMENDMENT BILL.

Mr. ALLEN, in Committee, to move the following new clause:—

For the purposes of licensing districts which do not include any borough with a population of not less than five thousand, sections six to eleven inclusive of "The Alcoholic Liquors Sale Control Act, 1893," are hereby repealed, and in such districts all the duties and powers imposed and conferred upon Licensing Committees by the Licensing Acts shall henceforth be performed and exercised by Stipendiary Magistrates. The Governor shall, by order in Council, appoint for each district the Stipendiary Magistrate who shall within such district perform and exercise such duties and powers.

Mr. COLLINS, in Committee, to move the following new clause:—

In the event of the licensed premises which a lessee is bound under his lease to keep as licensed premises being closed as the result of a poll of the electors of the district, or being closed by a Licensing Committee for a cause not arising from an act or default of the lessee, then the lessee may, if he desire to terminate the lease, give written notice to the lessor, and on the expiration of fourteen days from the giving of such notice such lease shall be deemed to be determined as by effluxion of time.
